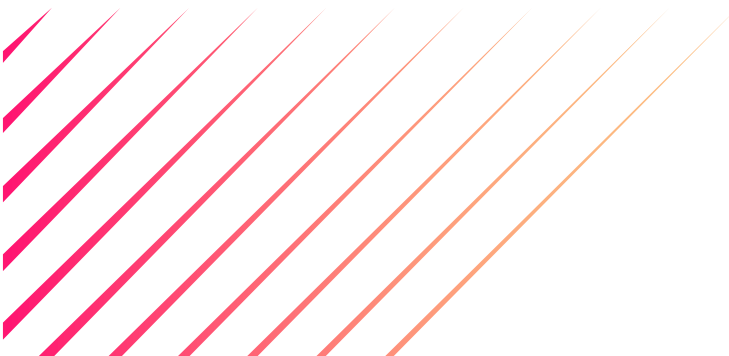


Skill & Simulation Training Report



Skill Lab, 8th and 9th April 2024

University College of Medical Sciences and GTB Hospital, Delhi



Summary

Sixteen faculty members which included members of the Skill Lab Committee and certain nominated faculty members from the dept of Anesthesia, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Pharmacology, Medicine from UCMS and GTB Hospital underwent Skill and Simulation training at the Medical Simulation Centre of UCMS on 8th and 9th April 2024. This training was held in collaboration with Laerdal Medical. This workshop marks a milestone in the Skill training of medical undergraduate students under the Competency based curriculum. Prof Prerna Batra, Chairperson, and Prof Sumita Halder, Coordinator Skill Lab Committee coordinated the training under the aegis of Medical Education Unit, UCMS.

Feedback

Fourteen participants returned the feedback forms. Out of these, the majority (79%) had never attended any skill training workshop. All agreed on the following points: This workshop would help in training MBBS students; the MBBS students would be more confident when they graduate.

Even though a majority, 71% of the faculty participants, said that they would be able to implement it in their departments, the remaining ones were not sure.

Most 46% wanted this workshop to be repeated for them once a year and a similar proportion wanted to have this once every six months, whereas the remaining 7.7% wanted to attend it again after three months.

The participants liked the following qualities in the workshop: Interactive, hands-on training, time management, coordination, and clarity of objectives.

Suggestions for improvement of workshop and future steps were as follows: Department wise module should be prepared, sharing of more resources, availability of consumables to be ensured, more hands-on scenario-based training to be conducted.
